1. BACKGROUND

The GHG Solutions Limited understands that your privacy is important to you and that you care about how your personal data is used and shared online. We respect and value the privacy of everyone who visits this website, www.highgroup.co.uk (“Our Site”) and (subject to the limited exceptions contained within this statement) We do not collect personal data about you unless you contact us. Any personal data we do collect will only be used as permitted by law.

4. WHAT DOES THIS POLICY COVER?

This Privacy Policy applies only to your use of our Site. Our Site may contain links to other websites. 5. YOUR RIGHTS

As a data subject, you have the following rights under the GDPR, which this Policy and our use of personal data have been designed to uphold:

- The right to object to us using your personal data for particular purposes; and
- Rights with respect to automated decision making and profiling.

6. WHAT DATA DO WE COLLECT?

- We do not collect any personal data from you other than as highlighted below. We do not place cookies on your computer or device, nor do we use any other means of data collection.
- Our site uses an order form for customers to request information and services. We collect contact information (such as name, address, telephone number or email address) from website visitors only when visitors voluntarily provide such information to The Graham High Group Limited.

7. HOW DO WE USE YOUR DATA?

- If we do collect any personal data, it will be processed and stored securely, for no longer than is necessary considering the reason(s) for which it was first collected. We will comply with our obligations and always safeguard your rights under the GDPR.

- As noted above, we do not generally collect any personal data. If you contact us and we obtain your personal details from your email, we may use them as follows:
 - To reply to your email;
 - To send you information about the company and the products and service we offer that we believe you may have a legitimate interest in receiving.
 - You have the right to withdraw your consent to us using your personal data at any time, and to request that we delete it.
 - We will not share any of your data with any third parties for any purposes.
- 8. HOW AND WHERE DO WE STORE YOUR DATA?**
- We only keep your personal data for as long as we need to in order to deal with your enquiry or until such times that you no longer wish to receive information about our products and services.
 - Your data will only be stored in the UK.

Once completed, the company will hold no information about you so you will not be able to respond to historic queries. The right is not absolute and only applies in certain circumstances.
